**Circular**

In view of ongoing season of vector borne diseases, we as responsible citizens are required to undertake preventive measures to safeguard ourselves and the public at large from risk of Malaria, Dengue and other vector borne diseases.

In this regard, as a part of preventive strategies to stop Malaria/Dengue cases during the season, all concerned are requested to take preventive steps by checking all the mosquito-genic situations for prevention and control of malaria, dengue and other vector borne diseases. The various Do's and Don'ts which should be followed are as under: -

1. Scrub dry and drain out the water from your coolers at weekly intervals.
2. Do not allow water to accumulate in the can, tins, tyres, containers, flower pots, refrigerator trays, AC trays & container for birds (bird feeding pots).
3. Do not allow water to collect in an around your house/shop/building/land/plot.
4. Do not throw junk articles and water holding containers on the roof top.
5. Cover your overhead tanks on the roof top.
